Verdict: Accepted

This submission concerns the occurrence of a Great Shearwater *Puffinus gravis* at sea off Port Stephens, NSW (32° 55'.09 S, 152° 34'.24 E) on the 20th November 2011.

The description and photographs leave no doubt as to the bird's identity. Members voted unanimously in favour of acceptance.

This is the 11th confirmed record for Australia. This sighting is interesting in that it is outside the expedited date range, although this record may still form part of the invasion that occurred between February and April 2011.
