Verdict: Accepted

This submission concerns the sighting of a Great Shearwater *Puffinus gravis* on the Continental shelf break about 28NM ESE of Sydney Heads (S33° 59.978' E151° 44.904'), NSW on the 9th April 2011.

The description and photographs leave no doubt as to the birds identity. Members voted unanimously in favour of acceptance.

This is the 6th confirmed record for Australia. However, this sighting forms part of what is considered by many to be an invasion into Australian waters, with reported records throughout southern Australia.
