Verdict: Accepted

This submission relates to a South Polar Skua *Stercorarius maccormicki* seen and photographed at sea off Sydney NSW on the 9th April 2011.

The submission details the diagnostic features of a pale / intermediate morph South Polar Skua including the pale collar, pale head & back, and a pale underbody contrasting with darker underwings. This is supported further with many excellent photographs.

The committee voted unanimously in favour of acceptance. This is the 12th record of this species to be accepted by BARC.
